Motion to host 1<sup>st</sup>. Annual War Bird fly .

I hereby propose to hold a War Bird fun fly on Saturday , July 10/17/24 , 2010 . The event will start at 10 A.M. and go till 2 P.M. ( or until all pilots have had a chance to fly ) . Donated prizes will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>. 2<sup>nd</sup>. And 3<sup>rd</sup>. place pilots who participate . Pilots will be judged on scale detail of plane ( viewed from ground ) and scale flight ( viewed from flight line while in flight ) . There will be a \$10.00 registration fee for AMA & MAC and OPEN pilots , a Hot Dog and Drink is included with your registration. Public welcome.

All pilots must have current valid AMA or MAC .

All pilots must obey all AMA safety rules and all F.P. rules . All pilots must register ( \$10.00 fee ) and check in all radios transmitters to the radio impound . All participating pilots must use an approved scale Military model aircraft ( fixed wing prop , jet or heli ) Example : A Yak-54 with a U.S. flag will not qualify .

Registration will open at Flying Pilgrims Club at 8:00 a.m. , Pilots meeting at 9:30a.m. Raising of the U.S. Flag at 9:50 a.m. , and War Birds will fly at 10 a.m. till 2 p.m. . Open flying will then be opened back up . Pilots must bring their own equipment for day.

Non War Bird pilots must register

and fly after the contest . This will be a non rule book contest open to all who can attend .

A donation prize raffle will be held as well as a 50/50 cash prize raffle . Hot Dogs and drinks will be available on site ( price will be reasonable ) . I John Tripp III will provide all proper permits to please local health department for the serving of food on site . All profits will be turned over to the F.P. Treasury .
